



It's a 1974 Super Beetle. 1600CC Dual Intake with stock style exhaust. It's always been red with a black vinyl seats and white headliner. The engine was rebuilt once, but replaced in 2000. Still have the original block and will most likely rebuild that in the future and re-install it into the car. The car has been repainted only 3 times with the last one in 1990. The bulk of the car is pretty much original, with newer rear fenders. It does show some rust, but for its age it's in pretty good shape. It's been driven literally coast to coast since it's been in California and Maine.

Volkswagen discontinued the Super Beetle line when all US production was cut in 1979 with only the last orders being filled in the states. After production was shifted towards the Mexican market, they only constructed the standard beetle. It's been owned in the family since 1975. The Owner is Aaron Vansteenburgh of Ames, IA.
