- **Klassy Kruisers Annual Picnic-** The picnic was held on Tues, **Aug 6th** at the Ogden City Park and everyone that were present enjoyed the time together. Best Wishes were also extended to Ray & Joyce as they (both) celebrated their Birthday today. Thanks to everyone who brought a dessert and/or salad to share and our thanks to Ray & Joyce for reserving the city park location and ordering the chicken for the picnic.
- Ray mentioned that he had old trophies and what to do with them, possibly looking into businesses that give awards
- Gilbert Days held on Sat, Jul 27th Aaron reported that we had 57 vehicles and of the 50/50 drawing the winner donated \$40 of the \$57 back to the club to go towards our donation to the food pantry. Aaron mentioned that the show had the second highest number of cars attend.
- Ron and Aaron also proposed that our club help offset the Gilbert Days expense to give \$75-100 to help pay for Kybo rental; Ice and Water that was made available to the show participants. After further discussion, Aaron made the motion to give \$100 to the Gilbert Days and it was seconded by Carrie. Motion carried. Ron also sent Thank you cards to our sponsors.
- Tony received a call from LuAnn at the Nevada Care facility in Nevada, IA inquiring if our club would do a Show n' Shine the (second weekend) of Sept. After further discussion, due to other scheduling commitments by our membership, we agreed the only date available would be Sat, Sept 7th Tony said he would call LuAnn at (515)291-7641 to determine if the proposed date would be agreeable. - **Website-** Our current Webmaster, Pat stated that he was resigning from the club effective Dec 31st due to his business workload. Tony read an e-mail thanking him for his services with the club and that he and Janet will be missed as members.
- Pat, also stated that the website would be supported until that date; and recommending that another host domain registrar be chosen early to minimize any interruption of data transfer. The club agreed to table the decision until our Sept meeting in order to check other host domain registrar possibilities. In addition, Carrie has set up a Face book page for the club which may also point to the direction of the proposed website furthering to increase awareness of the clubs activities.
